SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Foil pie plate Yarn or string Hole punch Scissors Ruler or tape measure Bird seed or bread crumbs





INSTRUCTIONS:

With an adult's help, use a hole punch to create three holes equidistant apart on the rim of a foil pie plate. Tie a 24-inch length of yarn or string through each hole and join the strings above the pie plate. Secure the strings to a tree branch, making sure the plate is level. Fill the plate with bird seed or bread crumbs.
